

Report on the P&C meeting for September 26, 2007.

The Principal's report contained updates on the ground stabilisation works being done around the school, the crossing at Gilba Road, the proposal to resume interschool sport and the FORMULA 1 In Our Schools computer design program for the TAS department.

We also learned of the poor financial state of the school and discussed ways of addressing this for next year. In particular the principal took time to explain the many extra costs associated with running a selective school (for example senior students often require two textbooks per course) and pointed out the fact that there are no subject fees charged at present.

The girls grey pants will be available for winter 2008. They will be supplied by Lowes and will have a small crest embroidered on the pocket to identify them as school pants.

The P&C donated \$400 to the school to provide badges for teachers, \$5000 to the Maths department for ICT equipment and \$300 to assist with chess coaching. We also discussed purchasing a sound system for the school gym.
